Focus Area:
FAMILY

Standard:
1. Increases literacy activities
beyond the classroom.

Objective: 2a Maintains a log or
journal to be reviewed monthly with
teacher/tutor that reports on literacy
activities done with children.

Classroom Activities:

- Student(s) will write definitions for vocabulary words and discuss.
- Brainstorm with student(s) literacy activities which can be done with children outside the classroom.
- Display a model activity: create a comic book with child. See attached Teacher 1.
- Students will develop a plan to use these activities with children.
- Students will create the selected activities.
- Have students create a journal or log to record the selected activities.
